



GROVE PARK & BEYOND – MAY 2024

Wednesdays at 10.30

All walks start at the Ringway Centre, 268 Baring Road – unless otherwise stated We walk for up to 90 minutes

We never cancel walks but may sometimes need to change the walk on the day

1 May The Tarn, and more

We will take the long footpath to Mottingham Lane, continue across the A20 and up King John Walk, for a bit at least. We will then take the path by the donkeys and after a short stretch of street walking do a loop around The Tarn. We can carry on to the nearby Fairy Hill Park and then return to the bus stop in Court Road.

8 May Peckham Rye to Elephant & Castle

For this walk we will take an **early** 284 bus (at 10.31!) from across the road to the Ringway to Hilary House bus stop close to Catford Station. We are aiming to catch the 11.05 train from there to Peckham Rye. The route is initially along the familiar Surrey Canal Walk to Burgess Park but this time we will continue north and eventually end up at Elephant & Castle. Return from there by train to Catford.

15 May Chinbrook Meadows, Sundridge Park, Downham

This familiar walk will take us through Chinbrook Meadows, then along the long footpath and King's Meadow to Sundridge Park followed by Shaftesbury Park and sports fields.

22 May New Cross to Greenwich

After taking the 10.53 train from Grove Park to New Cross we will walk through several parks and along the River Thames before crossing the Deptford Creek swing bridge and continuing to Cutty Sark where the walk ends.

29 May Lee Green to Eltham

For this walk we will meet at Leagate (opposite Sainsbury's Lee Green). From there we will walk towards Kidbrooke Village. We will then head south through Cator Park and Sutcliffe Park. Further along we will traverse Queenscroft Park before reaching Eltham High Street which is the end of the walk.
